<u>DEVELOPING THE MUCH-NEEDED PATIENCE IN</u> <u>TODAY'S HASTY WORLD</u>

"It is better to be patient than powerful. It is better to win control over yourself than over whole cities." Proverbs 16:32 (GNT)

- "... Impatience will get you into trouble." Proverbs 19:2 (GNT)
- "... Is your life full of difficulties...? ... Be happy, for when the way is rough, your patience has a chance to grow!" James 1:2-3 (TLB)

GOD'S PART: HE PROVIDES THE CIRCUMSTANCES FOUR kinds of "opportunities":

- <u>INTERRUPTIONS</u>
- INCONVENIENCES
- IRRITATIONS
- INACTIVITY

There are <u>three</u> major areas in our life that is guaranteed to sabotage our patience.

1. When circumstances are UNCONTROLLABLE

"Be patient then, brothers, until the Lord's coming. See how the <u>farmer</u> waits for the land to yield its valuable crop and how patient he is..." James 5:7

2. When people are **UNCHANGEABLE**

"As an example of patience in the face of suffering, take <u>the</u> <u>prophets</u> who spoke in the name of the Lord." James 5:10

3. When problems are **UNEXPLAINABLE**

"You have heard of <u>Job's</u> perseverance..." James 5:11b

MY PART: RESPONDING POSITIVELY. HOW?

a) <u>DISCOVER</u> A BIGGER PERSPECTIVE

"A man's <u>wisdom</u> gives him patience. It is his glory to overlook an offense." Proverbs 19:11

"A patient man has great understanding, but a quick-tempered man displays his folly." Proverbs 14:29

b) DEVELOP A SENSE OF HUMOR

"A relaxed attitude lengthens a man's life..." Proverbs 14:30 (TLB)

"The one enthroned in Heaven laughs..." Psalm 2:4

c) <u>DEEPEN</u> YOUR LOVE

"Love is patient..." 1 Corinthians 13:4

"... Be patient with each other, making [allowances] for each other's faults <u>because of your love</u>." Ephesians 4:2 (TLB)

d) <u>DEPEND</u> ON JESUS' STRENGTH AND POWER

"May He strengthen you, in His glorious might, with <u>ample</u> <u>power</u> to meet <u>whatever comes</u> with fortitude, <u>patience</u> and joy!" Colossians 1:11

When I depend on Jesus:

■ I wait EXPECTANTLY.

I wait QUIETLY.

"It is good... to... wait quietly for the salvation of the Lord." Lamentations 3:26 (TLB)
