(3) POSSIBLE ATTITUDES TOWARD PEOPLE

I. I CAN KEEP MY DISTANCE.

"There was a man who was going down from Jerusalem to Jericho when robbers attacked him, stripped him, and beat him up, leaving him half dead. It so happened that a Priest was going down that road; but when he saw the man, he walked on by on the other side."

II. I CAN BE CURIOUS BUT UNCARING.

"In the same way a Levite also came there, went over and looked at the man, but then walked on by on the other side." Luke 10:32

III. I CAN SHOW KINDNESS.

"But a Samaritan who was traveling that way came upon the man, and when he saw him, his heart was filled with pity." Luke 10:33

HOW CAN I BECOME A KINDER PERSON?

• I MUST SEE THE NEEDS OF PEOPLE AROUND ME.

"... When he saw the man's condition, his heart went out to him."
Luke 10:33 (MSG)

"... Look out for the good of others..." 1 Corinthians 10:24 (NCV)

• I MUST SYMPATHIZE WITH THEIR PAIN.

"... When he saw him, his heart was filled with compassion."
Luke 10:33 (ESV)

A KEY TO KINDNESS:

STOP ASKING: WHAT IS WRONG WITH THEM?

START ASKING: WHAT HAPPENED TO THEM?

• I MUST SEIZE THE MOMENT TO HELP.

"He went to him and bandaged his wounds, pouring on oil and wine." Luke 10:34a

"[Whenever] we have the opportunity to help anyone, we should do it! But we should give special attention to those who are in the family of believers." Galatians 6:10 (NCV)

• I MUST SPEND WHATEVER IT TAKES.
